In her World Cup victory speech to the nation, US Women's Soccer Captain Megan Rapinoe pronounced 'we gotta love more, hate less.' Despite the rapturous applause, her comments attracted 1.1K likes and 1.5K dislikes on YouTube and provoked a vicious response from the Trump Administration, who accused her of being 'un-American.' In this 40-minute talk, Prof Lesley Lokko, outgoing Director of the Graduate School of Architecture (GSA) and new Dean of CUNY, NYC will discuss the founding of the GSA and the role that love - often regarded as peripheral, inappropriate and a suspiciously feminine trope - plays in thinking, making and 'doing' architecture. Prof Lokko's talk will include two recent films, 'The Master's House' and 'A Manifesto of Feminist Upheaval', made by staff and students at the GSA for the global Women in Architecture film competition.
